## vMeye APP FOR iPad DEVICES

This app is neither developed nor maintained by Optiview. We provide this manual only as a courtesy to our valuable customers

Customers who wish to view their DVRs on line through their iPad mobile device must follow these instructions step by step.

1. Go to App Store on your device; in the search bar type in *vmeye*, and press search.





2. You will see a search result page like the one bellow. Click the *install* icon.







3. After the application is installed, go to the app screen on your iPad and look for the vMeye icon. Click on it to open the app.



4. After the app opens, turn your iPad sideways to have a complete view of the menus. Then click on *Live Video*.



5. On the next screen click on the + (plus) sign to add a new server.





Enter the server information on the fields shown then click *Save*.
(if you wish to add multiple DVRs you can do so repeating the previous steps)



7. After the server information is saved, you will see a list of the DVRs added.
